Welcome to the first edition of the Michaelsen Ministries Monitor!



Signs of the times



It would seem those days are at an end. Since the 1960's, God has been ignominiously and systematically evicted from our schools, the military and the public arena. According to British Education Secretary, Nicky Morgan, children who say homosexuality is 'wrong' or 'evil' are likely to be flagged by teachers as "potential extremists under Government guidelines intended to prevent Islamist terrorism...Traditionalist Christians said Mrs. Morgan's remarks implied that anyone who raised their children in line with conservative religious teaching on sexuality would now be viewed with suspicion." That perspective is increasingly becoming a trend in our own schools across the country, as our children, even in kindergarten and the first grade, are desensitized and, in effect, indoctrinated on the issue of same-sex marriage through the school curriculum as well as through cartoons such as "The Bravest Knight Who Ever Lived," based on a previously published children's book by Daniel Errico, in which the young hero rescues a lovely princess and prince, and then weds the handsome prince, who also happens to be an older man.



A 9 foot bronze statue of the Baphomet - Satan - flanked by two wide-eyed children, was unveiled by the Satanic Temple on July 27, 2015 at a ticketed private event in Detroit. The Satanists have threatened that any State Court that has the temerity to publicly display the Ten Commandments will see the erecting of said satanic statue on the same venue. ACLJ Attorney, Jay Sekulow has pointed out, however, that it is an "utterly false narrative...being advanced in Arkansas and elsewhere that if a government body displays a privately donated Ten Commandments monument for historical reasons, it is legally required to accept and display any and all other monuments by a private individual or group, even those

"It will come about in that day that I will make Jerusalem a heavy stone for all the peoples; all who lift it will be severely injured. And all the nations of the earth will be gathered against it...And in that day I will set about to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem" Zechariah 12:3, 9

"For thus says the Lord of hosts, 'After glory He has sent me against the nations which plunder you, for he who touches you, touches the apple of His eye.' " Zechariah 2:8.



Another profoundly significant event for the future of the United States of America took place June 26, 2015. On this date, five individuals in the Supreme Court of the United States essentially declared that God is an unloving, narrow-minded, behind-the-times bigot who clearly doesn't care as much about people as they do. With the stroke of pen, five breathtakingly arrogant, unelected lawyers legalized same-sex marriage in all 50 states, thereby changing the definition of marriage that has been the foundation of society for over 5,000 years.

All those who take God and the Bible seriously now find themselves officially on the wrong side of political correctness and in danger of legal sanctions and financial ruin. We have yet to see the ramifications and impact this will have on those committed to a Biblical faith, but hints of what is likely in store have already been made clear through the Government's recent dealings with Hobby Lobby, The Little Sisters of the Poor, bakers, wedding planners and photographers. Please understand: the objection many Christians have to the Supreme Courts' redefinition of marriage is not a matter of hating anyone. Jesus certainly was the personification of genuine love. He did not shun or condemn the prostitute. He had dinner with sinners and the Jewish version of IRS. He did not shame or call for the stoning of the woman taken in adultery. Yet His word to her was "Go and sin no more."

"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God...But God demonstrates His own love toward us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 3:23; 5:8).

- I was scheduled to do a radio interview with Cindy Hartline (www.loveforthetruthradio.com) on June 22, but their town got hit with a tornado...a small one, but still big enough to cause some serious disruption to our broadcasting plans. We rescheduled for July 10th and spent an intense hour discussing The Beautiful Side of Evil and why it so vital that the Church be alert to spiritual deception and syncretism. - Saturday June 27, I had the privilege of speaking to the ladies of Breakwater Church in Redondo Beach, CA. I shared part of my personal testimony with them, focusing especially on how easy it is for a sincere, devoted Christian to get involved in beliefs and practices straight out of shamanism and the occult. All that is needed to find yourself inadvertently embracing doctrines of demons (1Timothy 4:1) is the profoundly un-Biblical inclination to accept "experience" as your measure of Truth over and above the revealed written Word of God.

RESIDENT AARDVARKS

Jesus warned us that massive spiritual deception, especially among Christians, is the key sign of the end of the age (Matt. 24: 4, 11, 23-25; Luke 21:7-38; Matt. 7:15-23, etc.). If He was right about this, and I tend to think He was, the subject of spiritual deception is one the Church chooses to ignore at her peril.

In Matthew 24, Jesus was asked by His disciples to tell them what would be the sign of His coming, and of the end of the age (vs. 3). Jesus then spoke of things which the world has experienced for millennia, but which He said would be seen

on a global scale in a greater intensity and frequency than ever before: wars and rumors of wars, famines, plagues and earthquakes. He warned that His followers would face great hatred, treachery and persecution, even from those who had once been brothers but who had fallen away from the faith (vs.10). He spoke of lawlessness and people's love growing cold. Rather like the subject of hell, all of these signs in Matthew 24 decidedly fall into the kind of subject matter that most in the Church would likely dismiss as "unpleasant" and "negative" and therefore unworthy of any significant consideration.

Yet the one sign of the end of the age that Jesus spoke of not once, nor twice but three times was spiritual deception:

"Tell us, when will these things happen, and what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?" And Jesus answered and said to them, "See to it that no one misleads you. For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will mislead many." Matthew 24:4

"Many false prophets will arise and will mislead many." Matthew 24:11

"Then if anyone says to you, 'Behold, here is the Christ,' or 'There He is,' do not believe Him. For false Christs and false prophets will arise and will show great signs and wonders, so as to mislead, if possible, even the elect. Behold, I have told you in advance. So if they say to you, 'Behold, He is in the wilderness,' do not go out, or, 'Behold, He is in the inner rooms,' do not believe them." Matthew 24:23-27

Randolph and I are well aware that discussion of these matters tends to make one about as popular in the church as an aardvark at an ant convention. Actually, "Resident Aardvarks" might as well have been part of our job description for the last 40 or so years. Yet the job of a true shepherd has always been to warn and protect the sheep, especially the ones who insist on wandering off to camp out in the pastures filled with spiritual loco-weed and tended by wolves in sheep's clothing.

Our collective inclination in the Church may well be to ignore the subject of deception all-together, but true disciples of Jesus Christ understand that we have been commanded to be alert and discerning!

"Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world." 1 John 4:1

"But the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will fall away from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and doctrines of demons..." 1 Timothy 4:1

"Therefore, I testify to you this day that I am innocent of the blood of all men. For I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole purpose of God. Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood. I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse thing, to draw away the disciples after them. Therefore be on the alert, remembering that night and day for a period of three years I did not cease to admonish each one with tears." Acts 20:26-31

How many Pastors or elders today can honestly stand with the Apostle Paul in making that assertion?
